<p><i>Blessing of Homes on Epiphany</i> An annual Epiphany tradition beginning in the Middle Ages is the blessing of homes on or near the feast day. In a special prayer ceremony, a priest used blessed chalk and holy water writes, 20 C+M_B 19 above the entrance into a home. The number 2019 is of course the year; CMB is abbreviation for Christus Masionem Benedicat, or may, "Christ bless this house." Those letters are also the initials of the three Maji, believed to be named Casper, Melchior, and Balthazar. The plus signs represent the cross. Through these markings on their homes, Christians visibly manifest and steadfastly proclaim the kingship of the Lord. A baptized lay person can perform such a blessing if no priest is available.
