<p><b>PASTOR'S CORNER</b>          How fickle people are at times! Today we see the same people who had celebrated the presence of Jesus in the synagogue at Nazareth become hostile toward him – because He dared to speak His mind. Dangerous! We might recall that The Lord's call to Jeremiah included a promise that, in the midst of opposition he would enjoy an inner strength to prevail over those who would oppose Him – and this of course applied to Jesus also.</p> <p>If we cut a pleasing figure the world will approve but dare to offer a challenge and the world can become dangerous. The capriciousness of the people in Nazareth causes us to reflect on just how fickle we can be when given opportunities to grow. We are often used to only one way and refuse to grow.</p> <p>Jesus wanted people to grow in knowledge of Himself and God but as they, especially the Jewish leaders, understood Jesus more their opposition toward Him grew and they wanted to put Him to death. In today's gospel Luke is telling us that we must take Jesus on his terms – not our own. Jesus was no politician who tried to cater to people's every want. He would be faithful to the mission God had sent Him on, no matter what the consequences. God bless you all. Fr.
